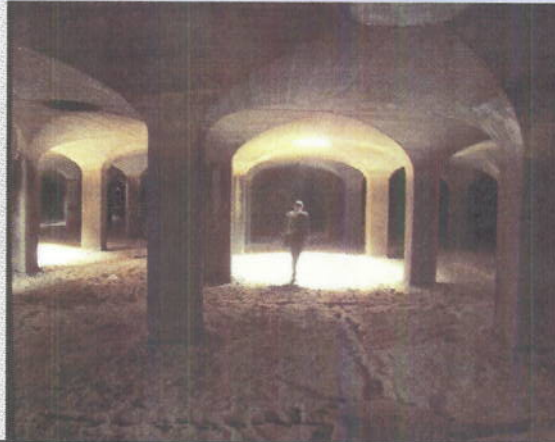
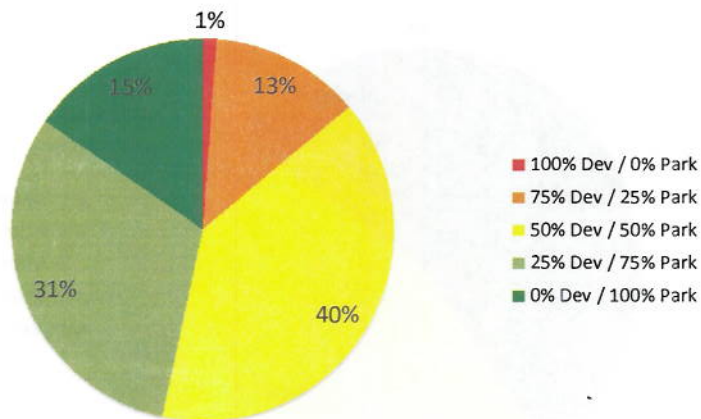


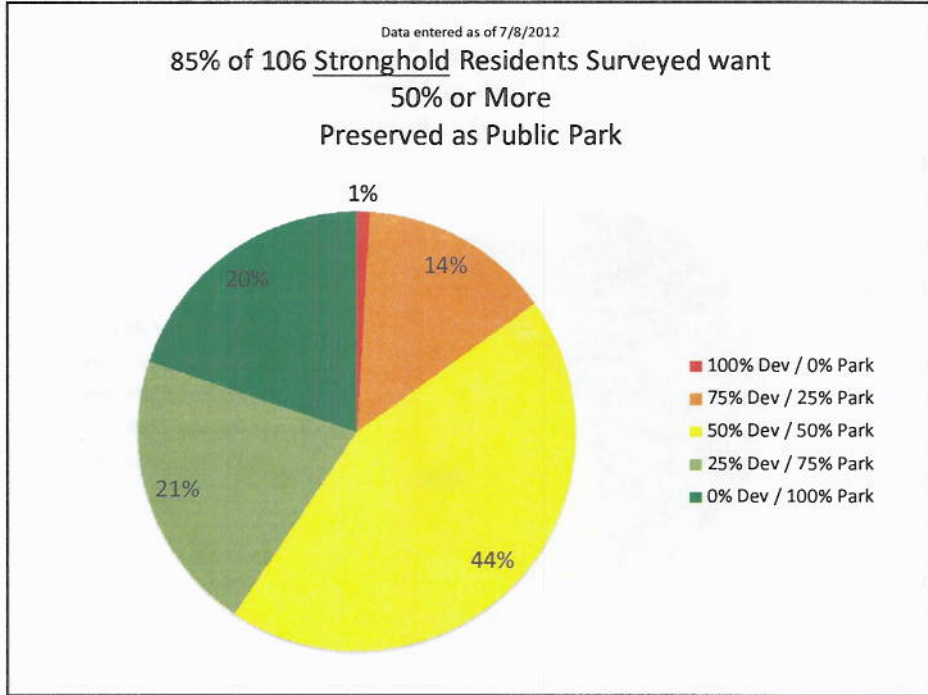
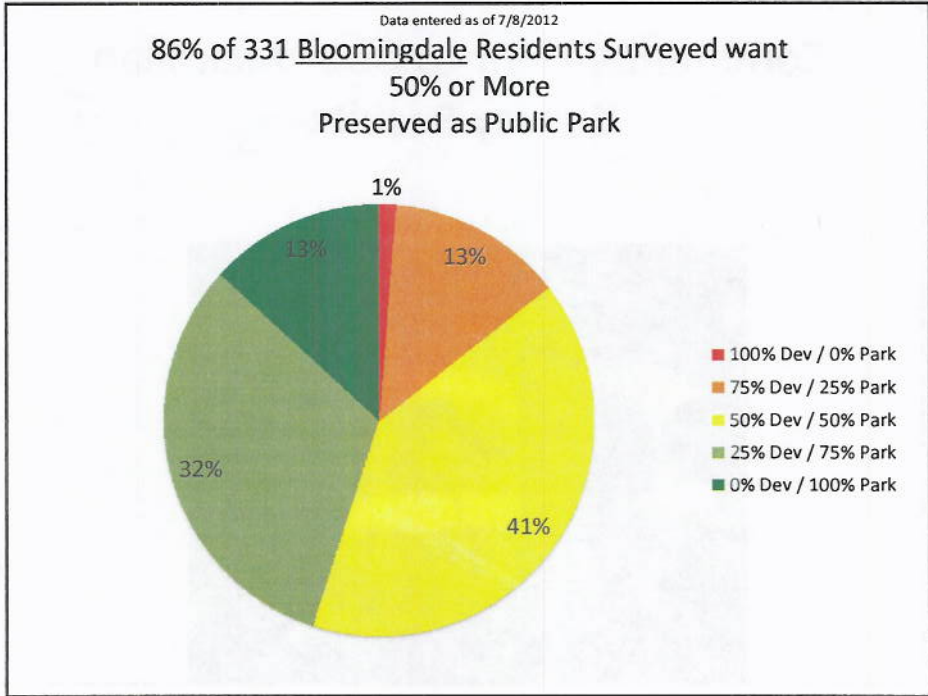
# Community Door to Door McMillan Survey Results Pertaining to Preservation

with data entered as of July 8, 2012

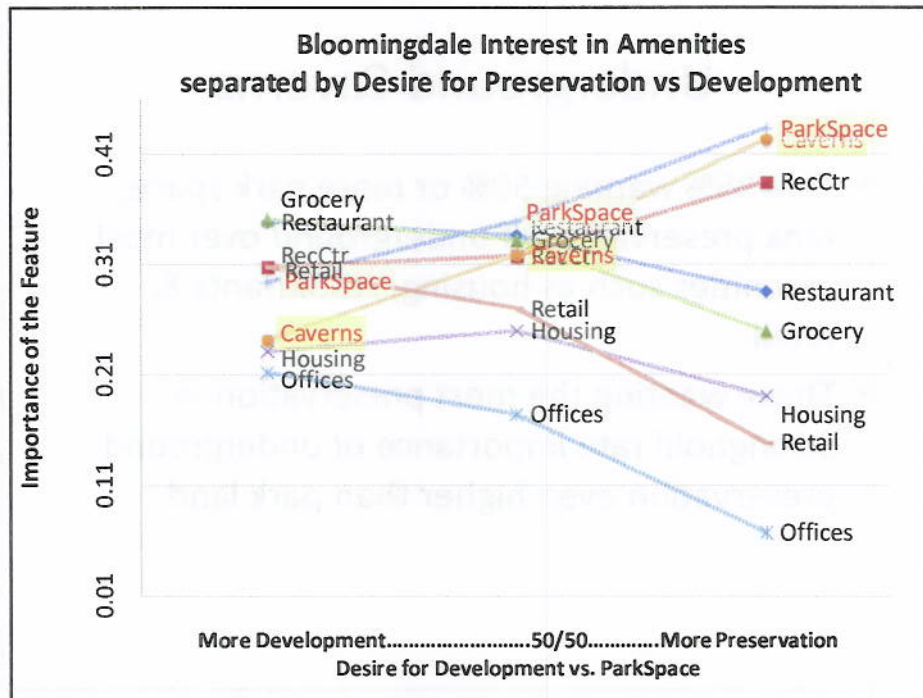
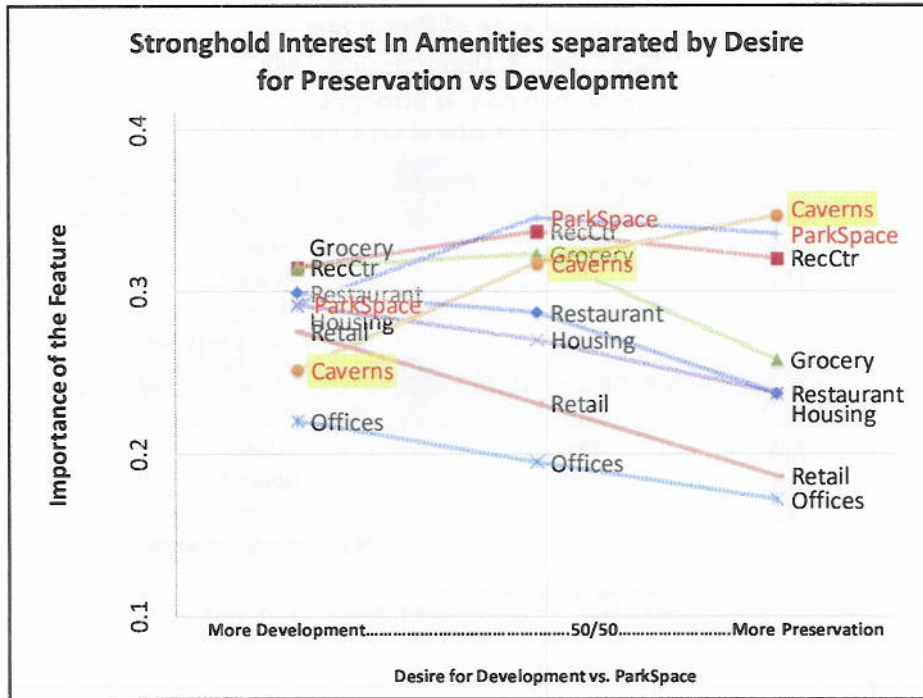

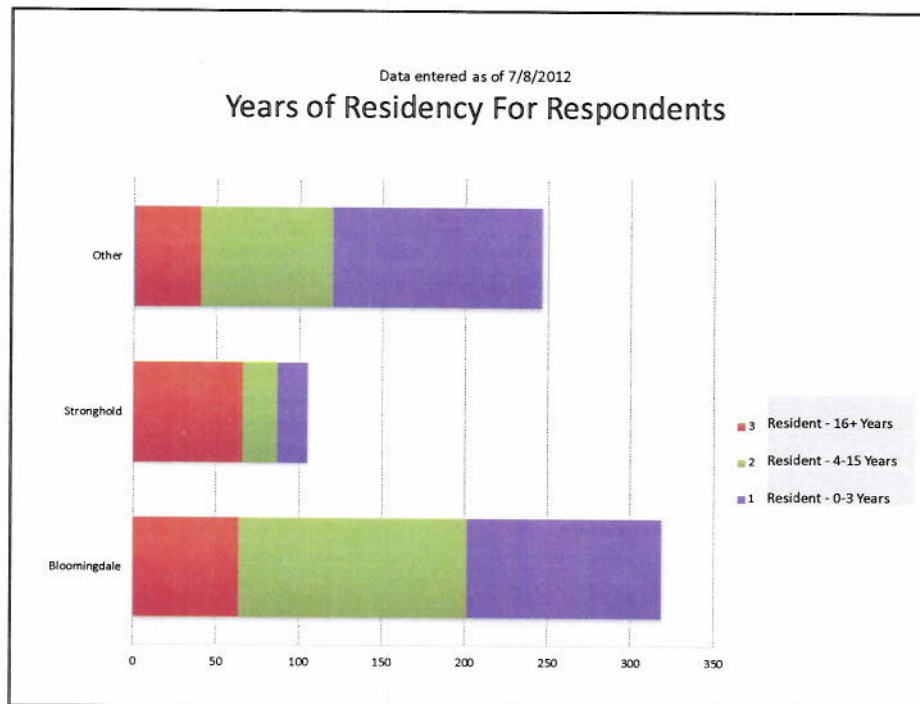

## Underground Caverns

- The 86% wanting 50% or more park space, rank preservation of underground over most amenities such as housing, restaurants & retail.
- Those wanting the most preservation in Stronghold rate importance of underground preservation even higher than park land.







### Bloomingdale & Stronghold Knowledge of Plan

- 87% (279 of 320) Bloomingdale & Stronghold residents know the city wants to develop the site.
- 60% have at least some knowledge of the current plan
- 35% attended at least one meeting
- 87% have at least some knowledge of the sites history
